Shirley Schallon, our director who has been ensuring the excellence of our preschool for over 20 years, is currently experiencing a health challenge from which her doctors expect a complete recovery. During the summer a mass was discovered growing on Shirley's spleen. Multiple tests have assured us that this lymphoma has not spread to any other part of her body. The treatment involves three courses of chemotherapy at three week intervals. After the therapy has shrunk the tumor, she will have surgery to remove her spleen. The surgery will probably take place in October or November. At this writing Shirley has completed the first chemotherapy treatment without severe side effects. She fully expects to continue to work during her treatments whenever she is able.

Miss Shirley is a beloved figure in our school community. As parents she has helped many of us raise our children and has always provided loving care to each child entrusted to her at the preschool. She greatly appreciates all of your prayers and good wishes. We will keep you posted on her progress and let you know if there are things you can do to help.

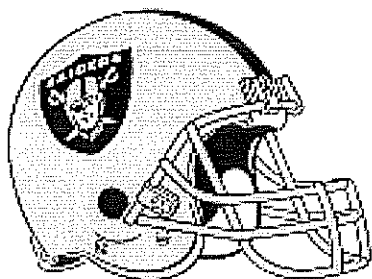

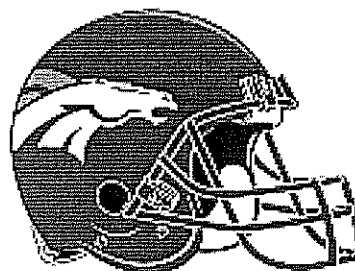

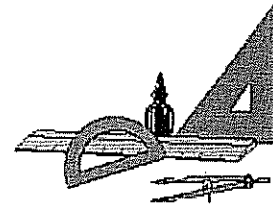

SEVERE ALLERGY ALERT

This letter is to alert you to the fact that we have several students and a staff member who have a **SEVERE ALLERGY TO PEANUTS** (legumes). For these people to ingest foods containing peanuts or peanut derivatives this **COULD BE FATAL**. For most with this allergy, simply coming within a few feet of peanuts or peanut derivatives can cause a **severe** reaction. Just the smell or contact with crumbs can set off this reaction. The worst case is Anaphylaxis – a generalized body reaction involving the skin, respiratory system and cardiovascular system. **IT IS LIFE THREATENING!** This reaction must be treated immediately with adrenaline. Most of these same people have serious allergies to other nuts also.

WE ASK SCHOOL FAMILIES' HELP...

Some schools, in the nation, are choosing to ban peanut containing products from their schools while others have arranged separate eating areas for those with this allergy. By alerting our school families to this life threatening issue, we are asking your cooperation in being sensitive to these individuals by not sending home-baked or store-bought products into school that contain peanuts or nuts. If you choose to send these products then please **boldly label them** as such ...**"PEANUTS!" OR "NUTS"**.

Beginning Band is for beginning instrumentalists in 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th or 8th grade. We meet on **Monday and Wednesday** mornings from **7:25 – 8:10 a.m.** on the stage in the multipurpose building. STARTING TIME IS Monday, SEPT. 12th.

BAND: We're going to be great this year, so, please arrive on time and BE THERE for rehearsals. Plan time in your schedules to practice!!

Beginning band students can rent instruments at Stanroy Music, Santa Rosa Music or any music store of their choice. You will also need to purchase the **beginning band book: Essential Elements: 2000.** Note that the Essential Elements 2000 is a MUST FOR THE CONTINUING STUDENTS!!!! This book includes a practice CD for the students. Each band student can also purchase a **portable music stand** for home practice. PLEASE ALSO SUPPLY REEDS (if necessary), and CLEANERS for good cost saving maintenance on your instrument. If your family has financial restrictions, please speak with Mrs. Ryan or Ms. Paulsen. It is possible to borrow an instrument from the "Music for Schools *Instruments for Learning*" lending library of musical instruments program on a need-based, first-come, first-served basis.

Tuition for band: \$360 per year. Can be paid in a lump sum or in 9 equal payments which will be billed on your monthly statements October through May. September tuition is due on first day of band. Tuition for families with more than one child in band will be \$360 for one child and \$180 for each addition child.

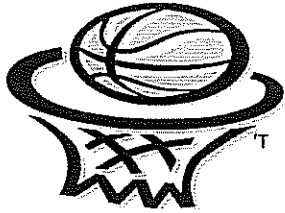

SAFE ENVIRONMENT PROCEDURE (REQUIRED FOR ALL EMPLOYEES & VOLUNTEERS)

The Diocese of Santa Rosa has a very strict policy regarding all employees and volunteers who have regular contact with the students. These employees and volunteers must be fingerprinted by Livescan under the Diocese and complete the safe environment training developed by the Diocese. All employees have met these criteria.

To be eligible to volunteer at St. Rose School & Preschool:

- ❖ **Complete the online registration and training. To do the online training go to: www.shieldthevulnerable.org and follow the prompts. The course is called “Recognize, Report & Prevent Child Abuse”. If you have completed that online course within the last two years, you may choose to complete the course titled Investigation vs. Inquiry. At the end of the course, please print the certificate and return it to the school office with \$7.00.**
- ❖ **If you went to one of the live presentations in October 2010 you will need to go online to register with the Diocese of Santa Rosa. You can go online to register at www.shieldthevulnerable.org. If you completed the live training in October you will just need to register – not complete the online training.**
- ❖ **Complete the Live Scan fingerprinting process (*The Live Scan form is attached. Upon completion of Live Scan please send copy of completed form to school office.*)**

What is St. Rose CYO Basketball?

It is a competitive basketball league. It is a not-for-profit program run by volunteers, coached by parent volunteers. St. Rose teams play teams from other North Bay parishes that make up the North Bay CYO League, and may travel as far North to Ukiah, South to Rohnert Park, West to Tomales, East to Napa. This is NOT St. Rose School Basketball, for that you must contact St. Rose School. Games are played on Saturdays and Sundays.

Who can play?

3rd through 8th grade boys and girls can play. Registration with St. Rose CYO requires players to attend St. Rose School or St. Rose Parish, or live in Santa Rosa on the North and West sides of town to participate. Players registered in one CYO program are not allowed to switch to another program. Anyone not meeting these restrictions must apply in writing for a waiver. The St. Eugene's CYO program is also in Santa Rosa, covering more of the East and South sides of town. There are other CYO programs for surrounding cities, with 13 programs currently participating in the North Bay CYO League. For information about other programs go to <http://www.northbaycyo.org>.

How does it work?

Boys and girls play on separate teams, based on their grade in school. All players' skills are evaluated through skill assessments. 3rd grade teams are picked evenly (by skill) by coaches. 3rd grade teams do not participate in post-season playoffs. 4th through 8th grade teams are picked by skill level by coaches, and placed in divisions based on grade and skill level. Teams of the same grade and division (skill level) from the CYO programs play against each other. The four teams with the best record in each division of each grade participate in post-season playoffs.

How do I join?

Register on line at <http://www.sportability.com/strosecyo>. Space is limited, and returning players are given priority, but we try to accommodate everyone. New players are registered, but into a temporary list. We reserve the right to refund registration fees if a player cannot be placed onto a team.

When does it start?

Mailers or e-mails are sent out to previous season participants in late August. Sign-ups begin September 1st and run through the 23rd of September.

Skill assessments will be held in early October. More information about skill assessments will be available at sign-ups or on <http://eteamz.com/strosecyo>.

Practices start in November, and the season runs from December through early March (8-10 regular season games, with potential for 1-2 playoff games).

How much does it cost per family?

2011-2012 season fees:

One player \$150.00 (including 20 raffle tickets)

Second player receives a \$45.00 discount (including 30 raffle tickets), must register in same online session

Third + player receives an \$80.00 discount (including 30 raffle tickets), must register in same online session

To all CYO Participants and Parents:

Welcome! Another season of CYO basketball is approaching. Any volunteers who would like to help would be greatly appreciated, please e-mail at the address above. We would like to share the work and train some help this season. Please consider volunteering for this very important role.

Sign-ups will be held online. Beginning September 1st, players may register online through September 23rd at <http://www.sportability.com/strosecyo>. Fees for this season (including raffle tickets) per family will be: 1 player \$150.00, 2 players \$255.00, 3 players \$325.00. Returning players are encouraged to register early. Registration priority is returning players who register on time, parish members who register on time, others. New players will be allowed to register, but team placement will depend on space available. A late fee of \$10 may be charged for late registrants, and late registration must be pre-approved. Players who come to skill assessments without prior arrangements will not be allowed to participate. Any uniform not turned in last season should be brought to skill assessments, and if you know someone with a uniform please collect it and bring it too.

We hold a raffle to help keep our costs down, \$20 (20 tickets) for one player or \$30 (30 tickets) per family. These costs have been included in the registration fees. Raffle tickets will be created electronically, nothing for parents to do.
