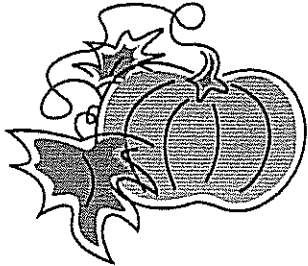
**SERVICE HOUR OPPORTUNITIES:**

When a student returns to school, a written excuse to the teacher is required which includes the date of the absence, reason for the absence, and parent signature. **If you also want to pick up homework, please make sure you request it each day.**

This allows the teacher to prepare the child for the interruption in the schedule.

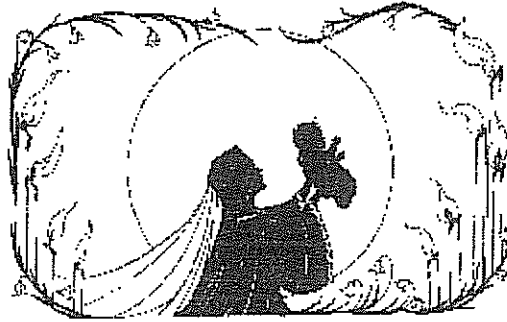

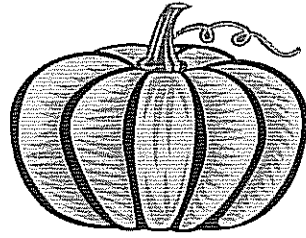
