TUITION ASSISTANCE

FINANCIAL AID OPTIONS ARE AVAILABLE TO ALL K – 8th FAMILIES WHO QUALIFY

Window to apply for financial assistance is January - March

St. Rose tuition is determined annually upon recommendation by the School Finance Committee.

- **Parish Scholarship - \$700 family discount:** Families who are certified by the pastor of their Catholic parish as active in that parish will receive a tuition discount. Criteria include Mass attendance, financial support and service.
- **Service Hour Discount - \$500 family discount:** Families who complete the required 25 hours of service within the school & parish community are eligible for the annual discount.
- **Multi-Child Discount:** Families with more than one child at St. Rose automatically receive reduced tuition through a multi-child discount built into the schedule of tuition.

St. Rose Tuition Assistance is based on need and is made possible with funding by the Baldocchi Scholarship Fund, the Knights of Columbus, the Young Men's Institute, and other benefactors. Also, an amount up to 5% of annual tuition is allocated to provide tuition assistance to our families. Family participation in school and parish is a strong consideration in awarding assistance. Eligibility for tuition assistance requires financial obligations be current.

All families who apply for tuition assistance **MUST APPLY ON LINE EVERY YEAR** with FAIR (Financial Aid Independent Review) at www.fairapp.com. **NOTE: You MUST submit your 2019 income tax returns with your application to be considered. Applications submitted without all required documentation will not be processed.**

Applications may be submitted to FAIR beginning February 1st, and the **deadline for FAIR applications is MARCH 2, 2020 for the 2020-21 School Year.**

The **BASIC Fund** scholarships are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis to families who fall within low-income guidelines based on the Federal Free or Reduced Price Lunch Program, **for students entering private school for the first time, in grades K through 8.** This tuition assistance is renewable annually up to 8th grade. **New family applications for the 2020-21 School Year will be available online starting January 1st** at <https://www.basicfund.org/how-to-apply-english>. **Deadline is March 18, 2020.** Renewing families will receive their information from BASIC in mid-March.

Notice of Non-Discriminatory Policy as to Students

School Student Non-Discrimination Policy

The school, mindful of its mission to be a witness to the love of Christ for all, admits students regardless of race, color, national origin, and/or ethnic origin to all rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school.

While the school does not discriminate against students with special needs, a full range of services may not always be available to them. Decisions concerning the admission and continued enrollment of a student in the school are based upon the student's emotional, academic, and physical abilities and the resources available to the school in meeting the student's needs.

PLEASE READ BEFORE COMPLETING THE APPLICATION FORMS

Age Requirement for Kindergarten Enrollment: The state of California requires a child to be 5 years old by September 1st in order to enter a regular kindergarten class. St. Rose will be using this date as a guideline as well. However, we feel that there are many indicators of readiness besides the date of birth. Please call the school if you have questions about this.

APPLICATION CHECK LIST

The following items should be attached to your application upon submission. We understand some documents may take time to procure. Please submit what you have available in order to be placed on the waiting list.

- Copy of most recent Report Card and Test Scores** (Grades 1-8)
- Attach Application Fee:** A non-refundable fee of \$25 per child is due at the time the application is submitted.
- Birth Certificate:** Please provide a copy of the certificate (non-returnable).
- Baptismal/First Communion Certificates:** Please provide a copy of these certificates if applicable (non-returnable).
- Recent Wallet Size Photo** of Your Child (non-returnable)

VERIFICATION of IMMUNIZATION Please provide proof that your child has had the required immunizations for school entry. **A child may not attend school without the following on file:**

- Copy of Immunization Record**
- Report of Health Examination for School Entry** (PM 171A): Incoming Kindergartners and 1st Graders are required to have a health check-up before school entry. (Kindergarten Physical's must occur AFTER MARCH 15TH in order for the exam to qualify for the 1st grade exam). This is mandated by the State of California Child Health and Disability Prevention Program. Parents will be given a "Report of Health Examination for School Entry" (PM 171A) with the application.
A completed PM 171A is due no later than August 15th.
- Incoming 7th grade students must provide verification of the Tdap booster before the first day of school.**

Letters of Acceptance or Waiting List Status will be mailed to all parents of kindergarten applicants by early-April. **Registration forms and fees for those accepted will be due in early April.**

PARENT'S GUIDE TO IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS
For Children Entering School or Child Care in California

THIS IS WHAT IS REQUIRED AT THE TIME APPLICATION IS MADE TO THE SCHOOL:

Parent/Guardians must provide a copy of the child's verified immunization record with the application.

It must show the date (mo./day/yr) your child was given each required shot.

IMMUNIZATIONS REQUIRED FOR SCHOOL

If your child's record is missing some doses, please contact your doctor or clinic soon to schedule an appointment for when these doses will be due.

State Law requires the school to refuse attendance to children until all requirements have been met.

The State of California has eliminated the personal and religious beliefs exemption. Your child may be exempt by a doctor because of a medical condition. If this be the case, an exemption signed by your child's physician may be acceptable. Contact our school office for details.

CHECK UP REQUIREMENT FOR INCOMING KINDERGARTNERS & 1ST GRADERS

Report of Health Examination for School Entry (PM 171A): Incoming Kindergartners and 1st Graders are required to have a health check-up before school entry. (Kindergarten Physical's must occur AFTER MARCH 15TH in order for the exam to qualify for the 1st grade exam). This is mandated by the State of California Child Health and Disability Prevention Program. Parents will be given a "Report of Health Examination for School Entry" (PM 171A) with the application.
A completed PM 171A is due no later than August 15th.

The school requires this form be completed by your child's physician or health clinic and be on file in our school office by **AUGUST 15th**. Kindergarten applicants should have this exam NOT BEFORE, but BETWEEN **March 15th – August 15th**. This is **mandatory** for all incoming kindergartners and new enrolling first graders.

REQUIREMENTS FOR INCOMING 7TH GRADE STUDENTS

Incoming 7th grade students must provide verification of the Tdap booster before the first day of school.
Proof that your student has had the Tdap booster shot must be provided before the first day of school.
